Jordan Meyer led us through the various discounts available to our insurance premiums by utilization of free training and programs offered by MIIA (MIIA Rewards). It is the goal of this committee to take advantage discount opportunities as insurance premiums are a significant cost to the town. These discounts can be earned through May. Automobile Max 3%; General Liability up to 4%; Law Enforcement up to 7%; Property up to 4%; Public officials' liability up to 7%; school board liability up to 7%; Workers Compensation up to 3%.

Jordan then led us through the Risk Management grant program under which we are eligible for up to \$10,000 annually, until their funding is maxed. Effective this year MIIA will pay vendors directly for these grants eliminating municipal accounting hiccups.

Our history since 2017 was a total of \$7375 in grant requests and were awarded on for \$2375 for body and dash cameras – which apparently was not followed up – as we do not have one.

Our previous utilization of the discount opportunities has also been negligible.

Jordan Koch accepted the leadership role as chair for this committee and Stephanie Harris agreed to be the alternate chair if Jordan is not available for a meeting.

Stephanie will be putting together some quotes for First Aid Kits for the various departments and submit a grant request through Jordan Meyer for them. Jordan Koch also had interest in dash and body cameras which was agreed to submit for.

Jordan Koch has also agreed to be point on running all NON-CDL license checks annually for any drivers of town equipment. This is another program offered through MIIA>

The next committee meeting was set for April 15th at 5PM at 720 Main Street, Savoy. Jordan Koch will reach out to both the fire department and school board to send a representative. We will be reviewing how we did at catching some of these discounts for this year.
